Monday 14th **Reflections for this week** – 'An angel appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt , and remain there until I tell you!" (Matthew 2:13-15)

Pray for those who are homeless/stateless because they are frightened for their safety. Remembering that Joseph, Mary and Jesus were homeless refugees too.

Tuesday 15th 'A woman named Lydia, a worshipper of God, was listening The Lord opened her heart to listen eagerly to what was said by Paul. When she and her household were baptized, she urged us saying, "If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come and stay at my home" And she prevailed upon us. (Acts 16:14-15) Give thanks for those who share their homes with the homeless and seek ways that the Lord may be calling you to give support to the homelessness,
